Benjamin, I.A.S. (retd.), Dr. Ittyerah C. Benjamin, M.S., M.Ch. and Mr. Ben C. Benjamin, B.A., hereinafter referred to as "the Endowment", and Union Christian College, Alwaye, represented by the Principal and Bursar, hereinafter referred to as "the College".

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Endowment has been established by the children of Professor C.T. Benjamin. Mrs. Susan Mathew, I.A.S. (retd.), Mr. Thomas C. Benjamin, I.A.S. (retd.), Dr. Ittyerah C. Benjamin, M.S., M.Ch., and Mr. Ben C. Benjamin, B.A., in order to honour the memory of their father.
- A corpus of Rs.4.50 Lakhs has been created by the Endowment Representatives and deposited with the Principal and Bursar, Union Christian College, Alwaye, in the Bank of India, UC College Branch, Alwaye.



- 3. The primary objective of the Endowment is to provide cash awards to students with the highest Cumulative Credit Point Average (CCPA) in the M.A. English and B.A. English Language and Literature programmes, for whole programme during each academic year.
- 4. The University's criteria for determining academic merit in the respective programmes will be adhered to when selecting the recipients of the cash awards.
- The cash award for the M.A. student achieving the highest CCPA shall be Rs. 10,000, and the cash award for the B.A. student achieving the highest CCPA shall be Rs. 5,000.
- 6. The Endowment Representatives would like to be invited to attend the prize-giving ceremony.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- Utilization of Corpus: The College shall utilize the corpus amount of Rs.4.50 Lakhs
 deposited by the Endowment Representatives exclusively for the purpose of providing
 cash awards to students with the highest CCPA in the M.A. English and B.A. English
 Language and Literature programmes, in accordance with the terms and conditions
 specified herein.
- Selection Process: The College shall follow the criteria employed by the University to determine the academic merit of students in the M.A. English and B.A. English Language and Literature programmes when selecting the recipients of the cash awards.



3. Cash Awards: The College shall distribute cash awards to the student with the highest CCPA in the M.A. English and B.A. English Language and Literature programmes. The cash award for the M.A. student shall be Rs. 10,000, and the cash award for the B.A. student shall be Rs. 5,000.

4. Prize-Giving Ceremony: The College shall read out a brief note about the Professor C.T. Benjamin Endowment during the prize-giving ceremony. Furthermore, the Endowment Representatives, Mrs. Susan Mathew, I.A.S. (retd.), Mr. Thomas C. Benjamin, I.A.S. (retd.), Dr. Ittyerah C. Benjamin, M.S., M.Ch., and Mr. Ben C. Benjamin, B.A., shall be invited to attend the ceremony.

5. Reporting: The College shall provide an annual report to the Endowment Representatives, detailing the utilization of the corpus amount and the distribution of

cash awards.

6. Amendments: Any amendments or modifications to this MoU shall be made in writing and signed by both parties.
