Greetings from UCC!

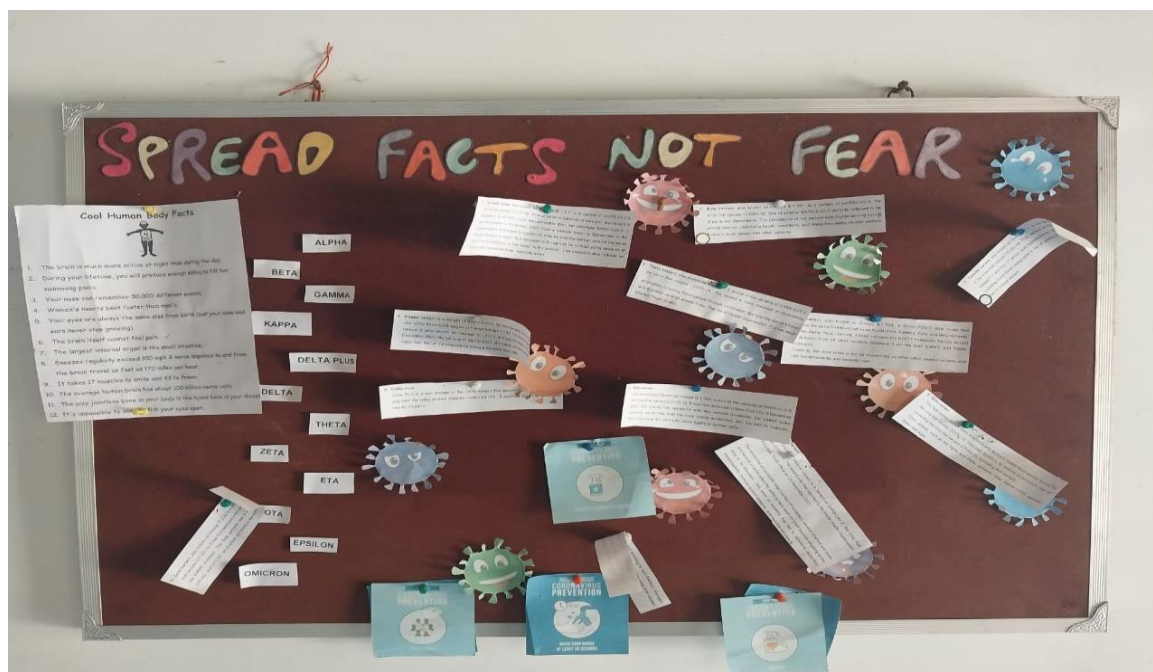
