



Psychology students provided Psychological First Aid in the camp, especially children benefitted more with the interactive sessions provided for them in the form of Play therapy and Art therapy.</p> <p>Students and faculty members visited nearby panchayath areas, housing colonies of underprivileged sections and Schools to interact with people and to provide psychological support in association with panchayat, health department and on the own initiative of the department. Students and the staff visited individual homes, community health centres for this purpose in months following the calamity.</p>

After that she explained about krebs
theory which describes about 4 Phases of disaster behavior

- 1) Emergent Phenomena
- 2) appearance
- 3) existence
- 4) disappearance.

krebs also explained that these phases of behavior
will also occur in time of a disaster

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28.08.2018. Tuesday. on Disaster Management.

The first session was conducted by Ms. Soji, PhD Scholar, V.C. College, Aluva. She began the session by giving an introduction about what is disaster. Man-made and natural disasters are the two types of disaster and they can have different effects on victims. and interventions are to be provided accordingly. A disaster can have physical, economic, social and emotional effects on victims.

Then based on different theories, she explained the different phases of disaster. One model suggests four phases of disaster - Enduring, Suffering, Acceptance and Reconciling, and Recovery. Another model suggests four stages of disaster - Rescue stage (72 hours), Relief stage (3 months), Rehabilitation (1 or 2 years), Rebuilding and reconstruction (lifelong).

The second session was led by Sr. Liji, clinical psychologist, Kusumagiri Mental Hospital. She began the session by sharing her experience at the camp at Bhalath Matha college where she volunteered. She explained the nine principles of disaster management. The first principle is that ~~no~~ no one is untouched.

There are 3 types of victims.

- Direct victims
- Indirect victims
- Hidden victims.
