The institution is compensated with value of A4 size paper of value as given below (whch can vary according to market rates)

White Paper : Rs 16per kilo

Newspaper : Rs 15 per kilo

Magazine : Rs 8 per kilo

The department may handover plastic waste (if any) for recycling but it has to be clean and free from food residue. For removal of plastic waste, there is a removal fee of Rs 50 oer sack payable to Plan@Earth as the amount approved by the government.

PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The Director, CSES, Padivattom Kochi, Ernakulam, an independent, non-profit, non-governmental organisation, promoting policy and action oriented research, consultancy and training programmes has proposed an intention of furthering cooperation with Union Christian College, Aluva, in academic, social research and extension activities. They have affirmed their intention to promote such academic exchange which will be of mutual benefit for both parties as per the below mentioned terms and conditions;

1. RECOGNISING the mutual interest in academic cooperation in dissemination of knowledge in research methods, field work and extension activities, the two parties, on a long-term basis HEREBY agree to establish and pursue collaborative initiatives of mutual interest on a basis of equality and reciprocity.
2. WHEREAS both parties have many areas of common interest, both parties acknowledge that considerable benefits may be gained by faculty, students and the institutions at large from the pursuit of academic interactions of the nature as listed hereunder.
3. The two parties shall seek to promote:
 - a) Development of mutually beneficial academic and other training programs for students, teachers and other stakeholders, including invited lectures and workshops/conferences.
 - b) Development and enhancing of research skills through conducting quantitative/ qualitative field work and data analysis training programs for students and teachers of UC college
 - c) Extension activities of the students of UC college through consultancy and training. Extension activities would include need identification of the people of a selected Panchayat/ Municipality through suitable methodologies as well as giving awareness on different topics like the various government schemes, digital literacy and so forth.
 - d) Reciprocal assistance for invited lectures and seminars
 - e) Research internships for students

- f) Coordination of such activities as joint research;
 - g) Exchange of documentation and research materials in the fields of mutual interests and transfer of concepts and ideas
 - h) Fostering social consciousness among the students;
4. Details of the implementation of any particular exchange resulting from this Memorandum of Understanding shall be negotiated between the two parties as such specific case may arise, and is subject to availability of sufficient funds.
5. Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the parties. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial academic collaboration.
6. Negotiation, implementation and operation of the MoU falls under the responsibility of the Principal of UC College, Aluva and the Director of CSES, Kochi. Issues about specific activities including rights and obligations of each party shall be notified or communicated to the offices mentioned above. In case, there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, the Principal of UC College, Aluva and the Director of CSES, Kochi, will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.
7. The Principal of UC College, Aluva shall nominate Department of Economics, UC College to coordinate the activities envisaged in the Memorandum of Understanding from time to time.
8. This Memorandum of Understanding to promote academic exchange and cooperation will be valid for **five years** and is subject to revision, renewal or cancellation by mutual consent and shall be implemented in the form of Memorandum of Agreement which explain in detail the rights and obligations of each party.
9. MODIFICATION / TERMINATION: This MOU may be modified, altered, revised, extended or renewed by mutual written consent of both the parties, by the issuance of written amendment signed and dated by both the parties. Either party to this MOU

may terminate their participation in this MOU by providing reasonable request of termination and subsequent written concurrence of the other. 30 (Thirty) days written notice is necessary to terminate the MOU by either of the parties.

This Memorandum of Understanding becomes effective upon completion of signature.




Report

Memorandum of Understanding

This deed of Agreement made on 27th June 2022 by and between the Manager, UC College, Aluva of one part herein after referred to as the first party and GX Archery Academy Stadium Link Road (Near IMA House), Cochin - 682025 represented by its Director Mr. Gokulnath.P hereinafter referred to as the second party of another part.

Whereas the second party has made a request to the first party, for granting permission to it to use the arena near to MBA/MCA block (south west corner of UCC) adjacent to seminary road , for giving Archery coaching to trainees aged between 6 to 24 yrs

And whereas the first party has agreed to grant permission to the second party, subject to the following terms and conditions.

Now, therefore, this agreement witnesses as follows:-

- 1) The permission granted is for giving training to the trainees for all days in a week (ie Monday to Sunday), commencing from **1.07. 2022 to 30.06.2023**.
- 2) The time allowed is from **6.30 am to 8.30am and 4.30 PM to 6.30 PM on working days and Saturday, Sunday and public holidays from 9.00 AM to 4.00 PM.**
- 3) Archery coaching shall not affect the normal functioning of the College or its students and the decision of the first party in this regard shall be final.
- 4) The second party shall not transfer the permission granted by this agreement for training in the arena, to anyone else.








- 5) The second party shall not carry out any work or alternation in the proposed area without the written consent of the first party.
- 6) The second party, shall not use the arena for any other purpose than archery coaching for trainees, matches for the purpose of training and competition. However for the first party has the right to regulate or restrict such matches.
- 7) The second party shall not give training to any trainee/person who in the opinion of the first party shall not be permitted to undergo training in the archery arena of the College and the decision of the first party in this regard shall be final and binding.
- 8) The second party will be fully liable and responsible for the conduct of the trainees and coaches during the training and in connection with the same.
- 9) The financial and administrative responsibility of the coaching program is completely vested upon the second party, and the first party shall not responsible for such and any other matters connected with the training.
- 10) The second party will have to pay the amounts for clearing, leveling, planting buffalo grass, construction of archer's stand and construction of store room at the back of Post Office and small compound wall near the old car porch area of MCA block. The income incurred for this will considered as the rent for using the arena for coaching archery.
- 11) The first party has agreed to provide a storeroom to keep the training equipments back of Post office. Toilet facility for the players will be provided by the College management. Both the above facilities will be provided at the sole discretion of the first party.
- 12) The first party has agreed to give permission to the parents of the players to enter the archery area during training given by the second party.
- 13) Either party can terminate this agreement before the expiry of the period of agreement by giving 7 days to the other party for violation of the terms of this agreement by the other party or any other reasons whatsoever.
- 14) On the expiry of the period of the agreement, if the second party makes a request it can be renewed for a further period, solely at the discretion of the first party.
- 15) The second party shall pay Rs.10, 000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) per month to the first party for granting such permission. The said amount shall be payable before 10th day of every month (see the clause No. 10).





- 8) All financial transactions and responsibility regarding the money will be entrusted with the Principal, Union Christian College.
- 9) The award money will be Rs.10000 for the best Malayalam PhD thesis awarded every year during the period from Jan 1st and Dec. 31st
- 10) The award will be named “Sinu Varghese Memorial Award”
- 11) All procedures related to the selection and distribution of the award are entrusted with the HOD, Malayalam department, UC College
- 12) All faculty of Malayalam department would be committee members entrusted with the duties in connection with the finalization of the award
- 13) Entries for the award should be submitted in print or book form
- 14) Proof of award of PhD should be submitted along with the thesis
- 15) Preliminary evaluation of the thesis should be done by the faculty of the Malayalam department, UC College (if necessary, a sub committee can be constituted for the same)
- 16) After the preliminary evaluation, five theses will be short listed
- 17) A Three-member committee may be constituted by the Malayalam department for finalizing the award.
- 18) The above committee will evaluate the five theses and select one of them for the award



- 19) The decision of the committee would be final
- 20) A zero plagiarism certificate should be provided by the applicant. Neither the committee nor the Malayalam department, UC College would be responsible for matters related with plagiarism.



PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The Secretary of Probhodha Trust, Ponniruni East, Kochi, Ernakulam, a public charitable institution engaged in social, cultural and academic activities has proposed an intention of furthering cooperation with Union Christian College, Aluva, in academic, social research and charity activities. 3. The two parties shall seek to promote:
 - a) Development of mutually beneficial academic and other training programs for students, teachers and other stakeholders, including invited lectures, workshops/conferences, academic competitions;
 - b) Facilitate exchange of students, faculty and staff of UC College with higher education institutions associating with the Probhodha Trust, for the purposes of research and extension;
 - c) Reciprocal assistance for visiting scholars and historically important places in India;
 - d) Coordination of such activities as joint research and transfer of concepts and ideas;
 - e) Exchange of documentation and research materials in the fields of mutual interests;
 - f) Fostering social consciousness among the students;
4. Details of the implementation of any particular exchange resulting from this

Memorandum of Understanding shall be negotiated between the two parties as such specific case may arise, and is subject to availability of sufficient funds.

5. Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the parties. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial academic collaboration.
6. Negotiation, implementation and operation of the MoU falls under the responsibility of the Principal of UC College, Aluva and the Secretary of Probhodha Trust, Kochi. Issues about specific activities including rights and obligations of each party shall be notified or communicated to the offices mentioned above. In case, there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, the Principal of UC College, Aluva and the Secretary of Probhodha Trust, Kochi, will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.
7. The Principal of UC College, Aluva shall nominate the Staff Coordinators of Gandhi Darshan Club of the College to coordinate the activities envisaged in the Memorandum of Understanding from time to time.
8. This Memorandum of Understanding to promote academic exchange and cooperation will be valid for five years and is subject to revision, renewal or cancellation by mutual consent and shall be implemented in the form of Memorandum of Agreement which explain in details the rights and obligations of each party.
9. MODIFICATION / TERMINATION: This MOU may be modified, altered, revised, extended or renewed by mutual written consent of both the parties, by the issuance of written amendment signed and dated by both the parties. Either party to this MOU may terminate their participation in this MOU by providing reasonable request of termination and subsequent written concurrence of the other. 30 (Thirty) days written notice is necessary to terminate the MOU by either of the parties.

Report of the MOU with Hedge School of Applied Economics and Union Christian College, Aluva (School of Management Studies)

The MOU between Union Christian College, School of Management Studies and Hedge School of Applied Economics was signed on 31/12/2022 for a period of 1 year.

Activity and Proof

The MoU was signed to associate with the company to provide Internship, Placement Assistance, Project Work, Industry Practices etc. to the students. A certification course in Financial Services was provided to the 60 students.

30 hours training session were conducted which included an industrial visit to the Hedge School of Applied Economics to understand the practical application. Classes were conducted in two batches in the month of February 2023. (13th Feb-17th Feb 2023 and 21st Feb to 25th Feb 2023. Sample Certificates for each batch is given below.





Outcome of the activity
