

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- 1) **Relieving Order:** That you should submit the Relieving Order, issued by the Head of the Institution/University/College at the time of your Registration i.e. on 05-01-2019 (9.30 AM).
- 2) **Registration fee of Rs. 1000/-** through Demand Draft in favour of UGC-HRDC, MANUU Hyderabad.
- 3) **Boarding and Lodging Facilities :**
 - (i) UGC-HRDC provides non A/c Rooms on sharing basis in its Hostel for outside participants on first come and first serve basis. Therefore you are required to deposit **Rs.4,200/-** (Rupees Four Thousand Two Hundred only) towards lodging charges (@ **Rs. 200/- per day** on sharing basis for 21 days) with the UGC-HRDC at the time of registration.
 - (ii) Besides, you are also required to pay **Rs. 300/- per day** on account of boarding charges for your stay period in the Hostel which is worked out to **Rs. 6,300/-** (Rupees Six Thousand Three Hundred only) (for 21 days) which is directly to be payable to the vendor at the time of registration itself.
 - (iii) Accommodation in the Hostel is restricted only to the participants and spouses or any other person shall not be allowed under any circumstances. This condition can be relaxed to differently abled participants provided he/she apply for exemption for the accompanying person.
 - (iii) **Reimbursement of Travelling Allowance:**


