Ref: Circular No.02/UCC/BP-G1/2017 dated 05.06.2014

As per the Circular dated 05.06.2014, the institution reinforces the rules and norms regarding the restricted entry of automobiles beyond a point in the campus to students.

As part of this resolve, the and students are directed to make restricted use of automobiles in the college premises. To accomplish the same, the students shall utilize the public transport facilities or pooling facility. 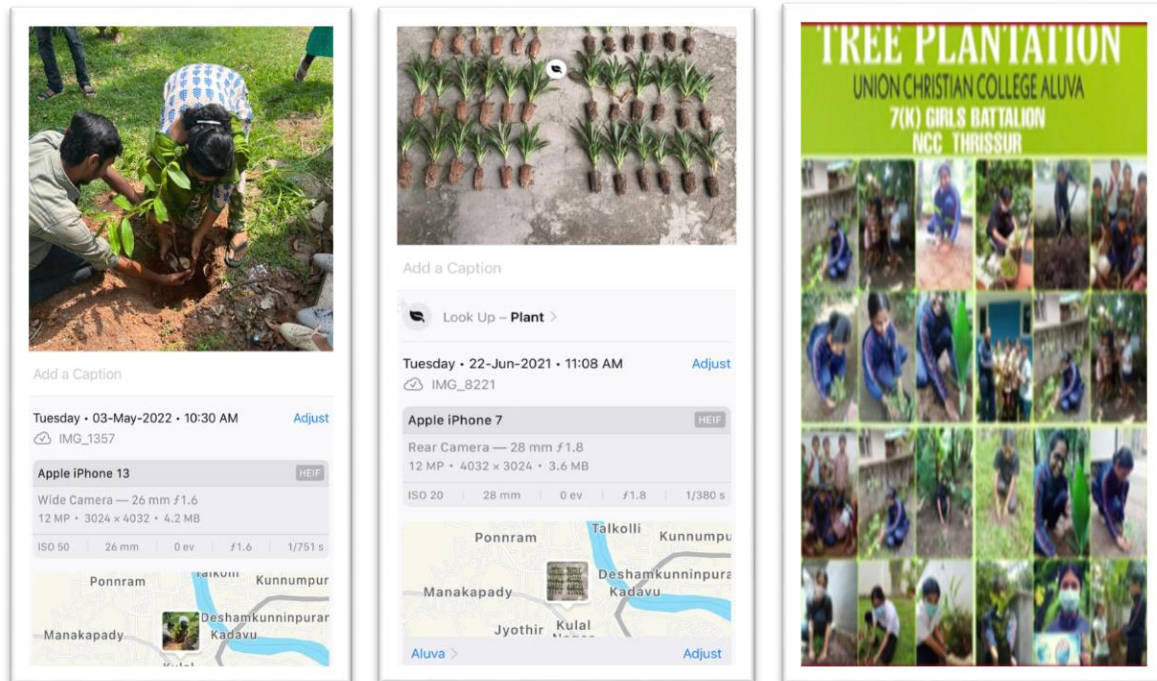
