
4.1.1 Infrastructure- Library



ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM

Started in 1974, the museum collects, classifies and showcases artefacts of historical and archaeological importance. The museum, along with a library & conservation laboratory, is housed in the Department of History and is open to students.





ZOOLOGICAL MUSEUM

The zoology museum features a vast array of specimens, including preserved animals, skeletons, taxidermy mounts, and anatomical models. The collections include representatives from various animal groups, such as mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, fishes, and invertebrates. Specimens featuring the developmental stages of various animals, including humans are also part of the collection. The exhibits also encompass an extensive collection of molluscan shells, corals, and permanent mounts showcasing diverse protistan species.
