

3. School Cleaning

NSS volunteers cleared up the ground and surroundings thereby creating a warm and pleasant atmosphere. Volunteers prepared an herbal garden in the school. They also planted saplings of trees in the school compound. The Teachers and PTA of the School directed the volunteers for the cleaning work.





4. Socio - Economic - Health Survey

As part of the Shuchithva Mission Programme NSS Unit conduct a Socio – Economic - Health survey in ward XVIII (Manakkappadi South) of Karumalloor Grama Panchayat of Ernakulum District during 23 – 25 December, 2018. Volunteers visited 396 houses. They also gave an orientation about ‘how can we reduce plastic waste’, ‘handling of bio waste’, ‘organic farming’ etc. We are planning to submit the analysis report of our survey by the end of January 2019 to the Panchayat and will take necessary steps towards improving the cleanliness of ward XVIII of Karumalloor Panchayat.

During the NSS special camp a '*Shuchitva bodhana yajnam*' rally was conducted on 26th December 2018. Volunteers prepared slogans themselves and the rally was set off from the campsite to Thattampadi **Junction**. All volunteers actively participated in the rally. 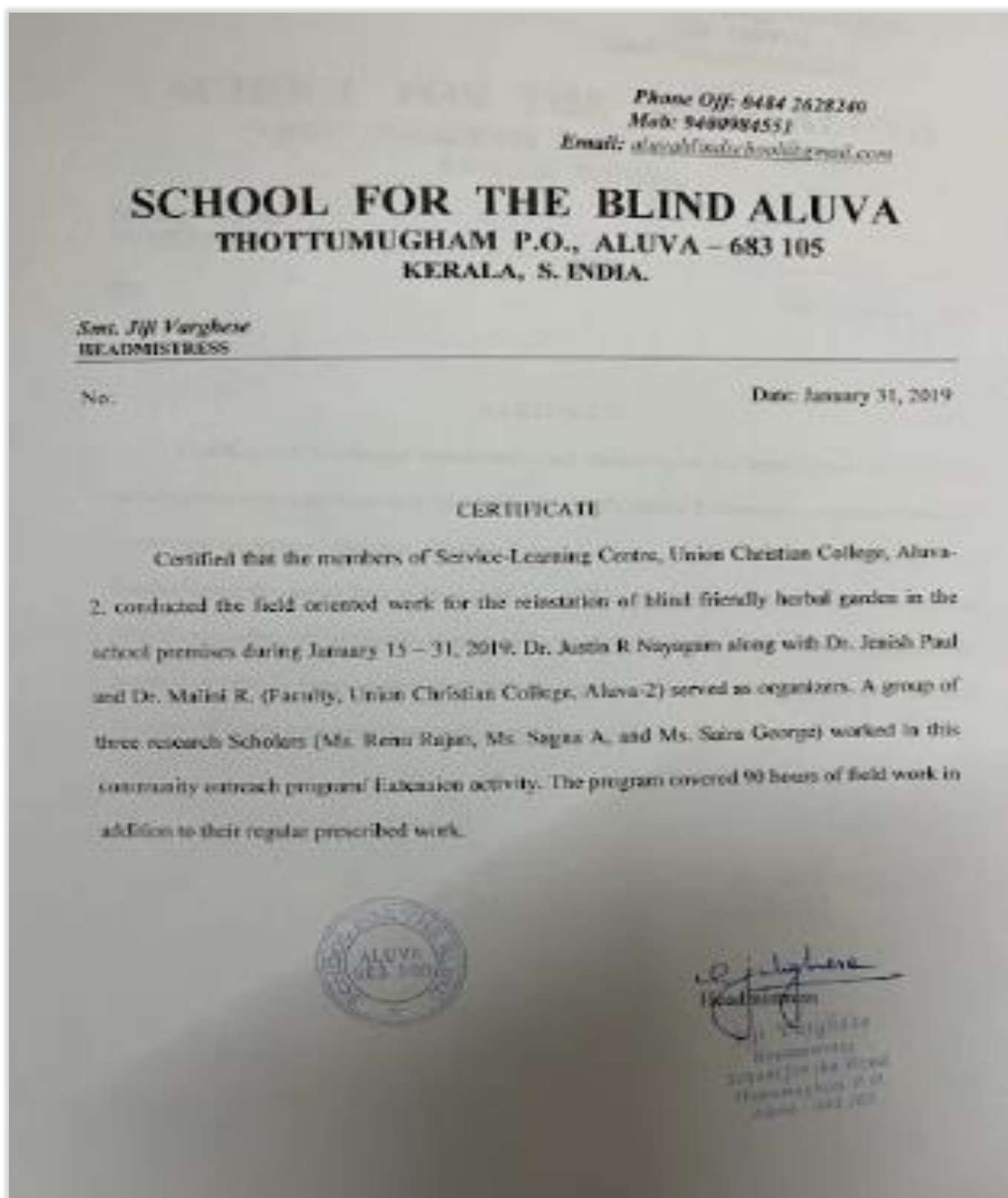
6. Vegetable Garden at F.M.C.T.H.S.S. Karumalloor

1. Seed Ball Making

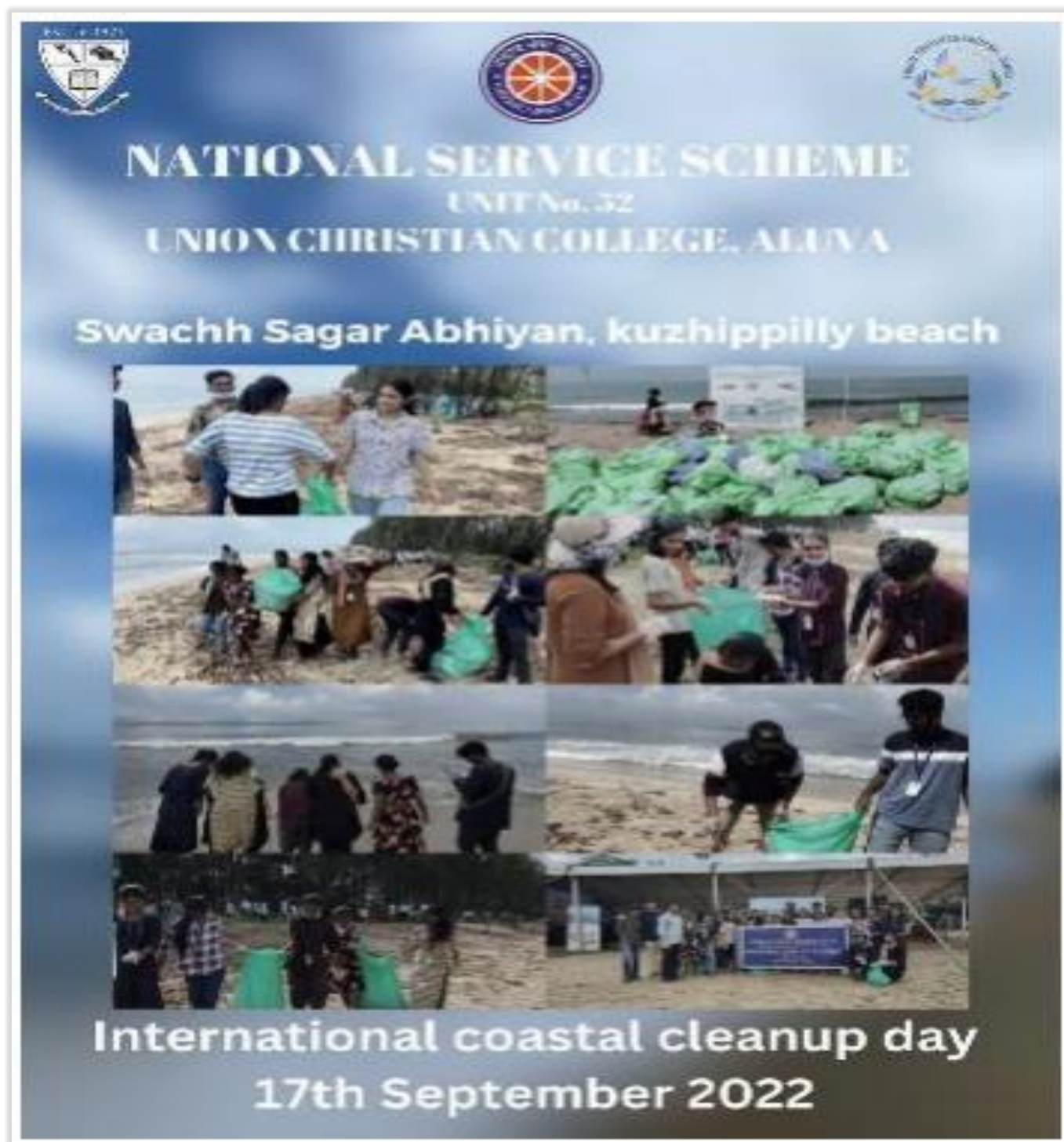
As part of NSS Seven-Day Camp in 2021-22, NSS volunteers made seed balls and distributed in the nearby villages.
