7.1.2 Report of Events



2018- 2019

1. Cleaning and Chlorination at Mambra

As part of disinfecting drive against the epidemic spread, several houses and its premises were cleaned and chlorinated by NSS volunteers at Mambra of Karumalloor Panchayat on 12th and 13th August, 2018. About 30 volunteers took part in the programme.





2. School Cleaning

At the onset, the one-day miniature camp held on 8th September 2018 aimed in joining the cleanliness activities at Chamaparambu Government L. P. School near to UCC, Aluva. NSS volunteers cleared up the ground and surroundings thereby creating a warm and pleasant atmosphere. Volunteers prepared an herbal garden in the school. They also planted saplings of trees in the school compound. The Teachers and PTA of the School directed the volunteers for the cleaning work.





3. Clean Campus Green Campus

Plastic is hazardous to health and is an impending cause of destroying our planet Earth. On October 2nd 2018, NSS volunteers engaged in the cleaning of UCC campus under the guidance of Dr. Justin. R. Nayagam (Assistant Professor, Department of Botany). NSS Volunteers collected about 139 kilograms of plastic waste from the campus and sorted the waste in a scientific manner. This activity invited the attention of other students of the college towards the cleanliness drive.







4. Socio - Economic - Health Survey

As part of the Shuchithva Mission Programme, the NSS Unit conducted a Socio – Economic - Health survey in ward XVIII (Manakkappadi South) of Karumalloor Grama Panchayat of Ernakulam District during 23 – 25 December, 2018. Volunteers visited 396 houses. They also gave an orientation about ‘How can we reduce plastic waste’, ‘Handling of bio waste’, ‘Organic farming’ etc. The report of the same was submitted to the Panchayat to take necessary steps towards improving the cleanliness of ward XVIII.





5. Shuchitva bodhana yajnam' rally

During the NSS special camp a '*Shuchitva bodhana yajnam*' rally was conducted on 26th December 2018. Volunteers prepared slogans themselves and the rally was set off from the campsite to Thattampadi Junction. All volunteers actively participated in the rally. This resulted in a better awareness among the society about the importance of clean surroundings

World Environment Day was celebrated in our college on 6th June 2019 by our NSS volunteers

From the one-day camp volunteers studied the art of cultivating plants. They developed a skill of working in the soil and they took oath to take care of the plants and vegetables they planted throughout the year. The volunteers planted 110 banana saplings, 65 tapioca stems and some vegetables. Seeds were provided by the Department of Physics. Cultural programmes were organized during afternoon session and were really entertaining.

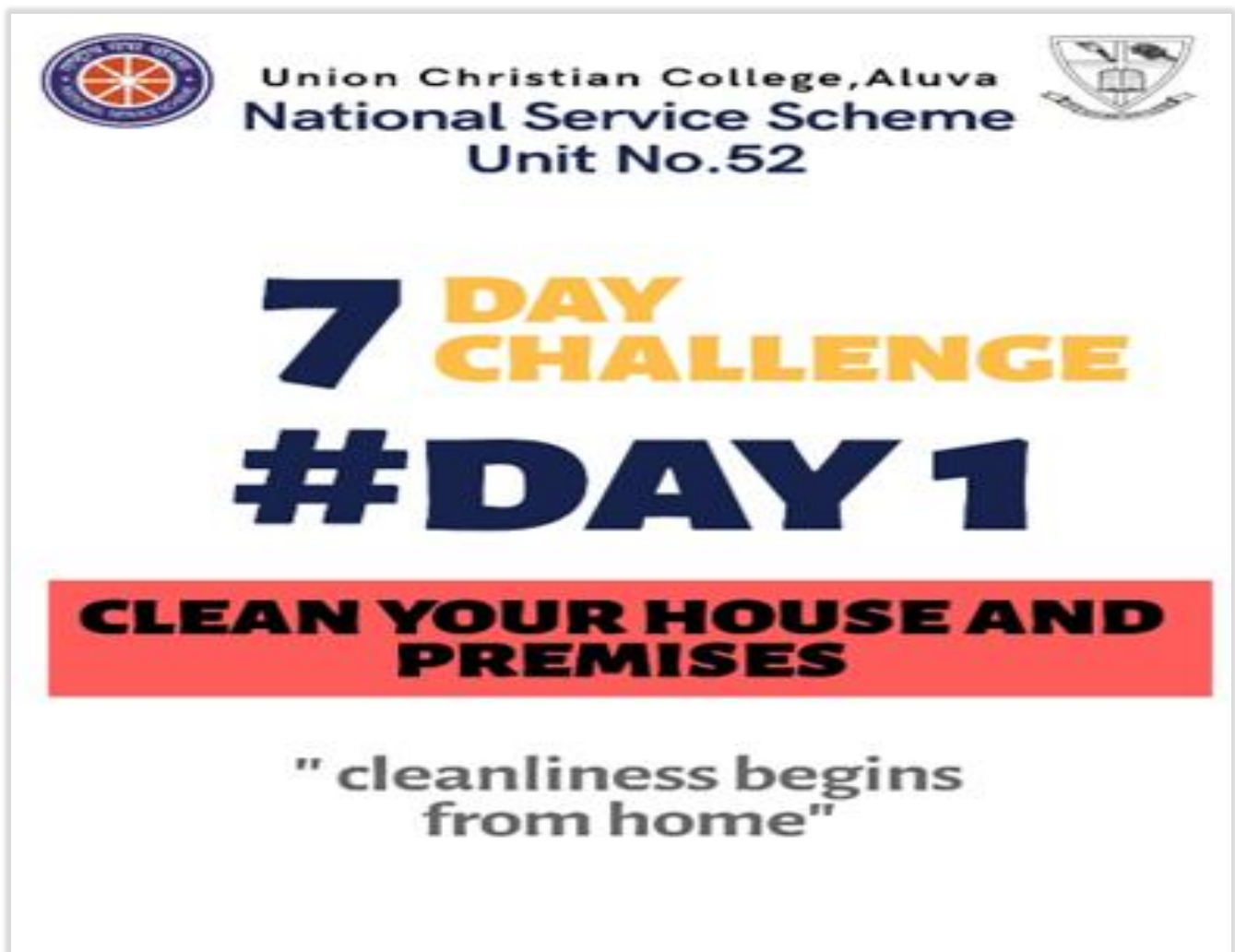

1. Tree Chain Challenge

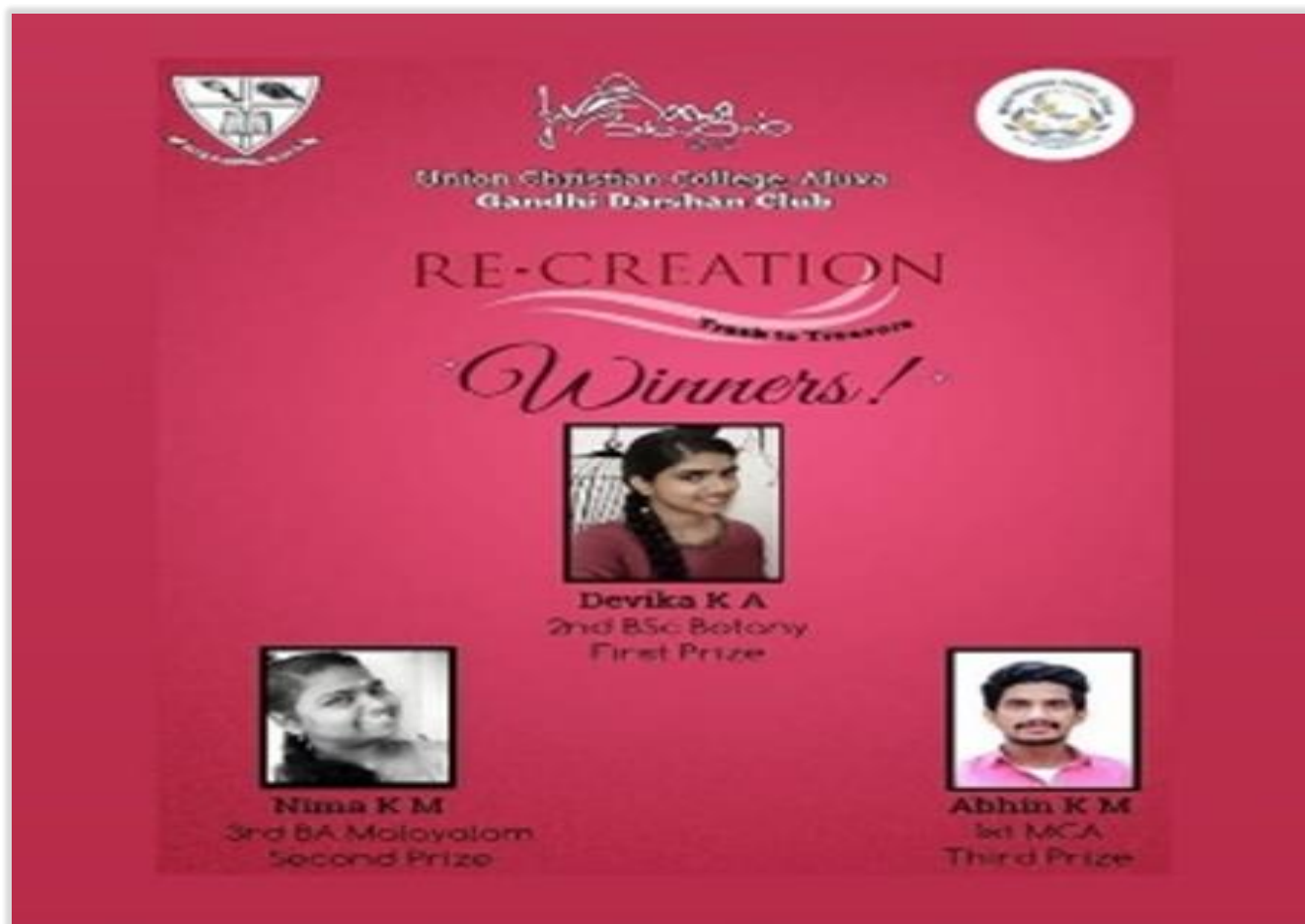
As part of World Environment Day, “Tree Chain Challenge” was conducted. by NSS Unit on June 5, 2021.

2. Inauguration and Distribution of Menstrual Cups, An Initiative of Honorable M.P. Shri. Hibi Eden On 01/09/2022.

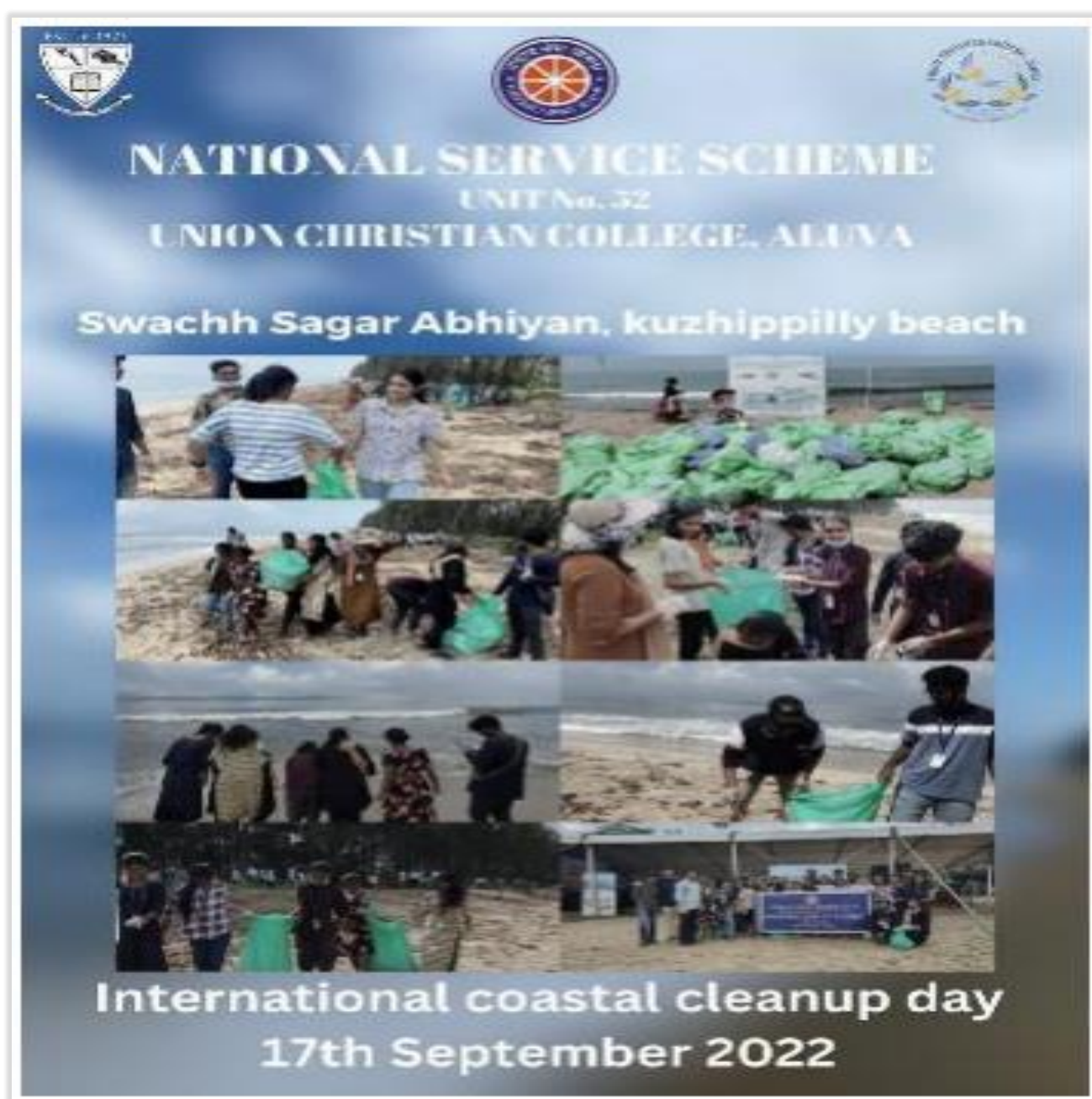

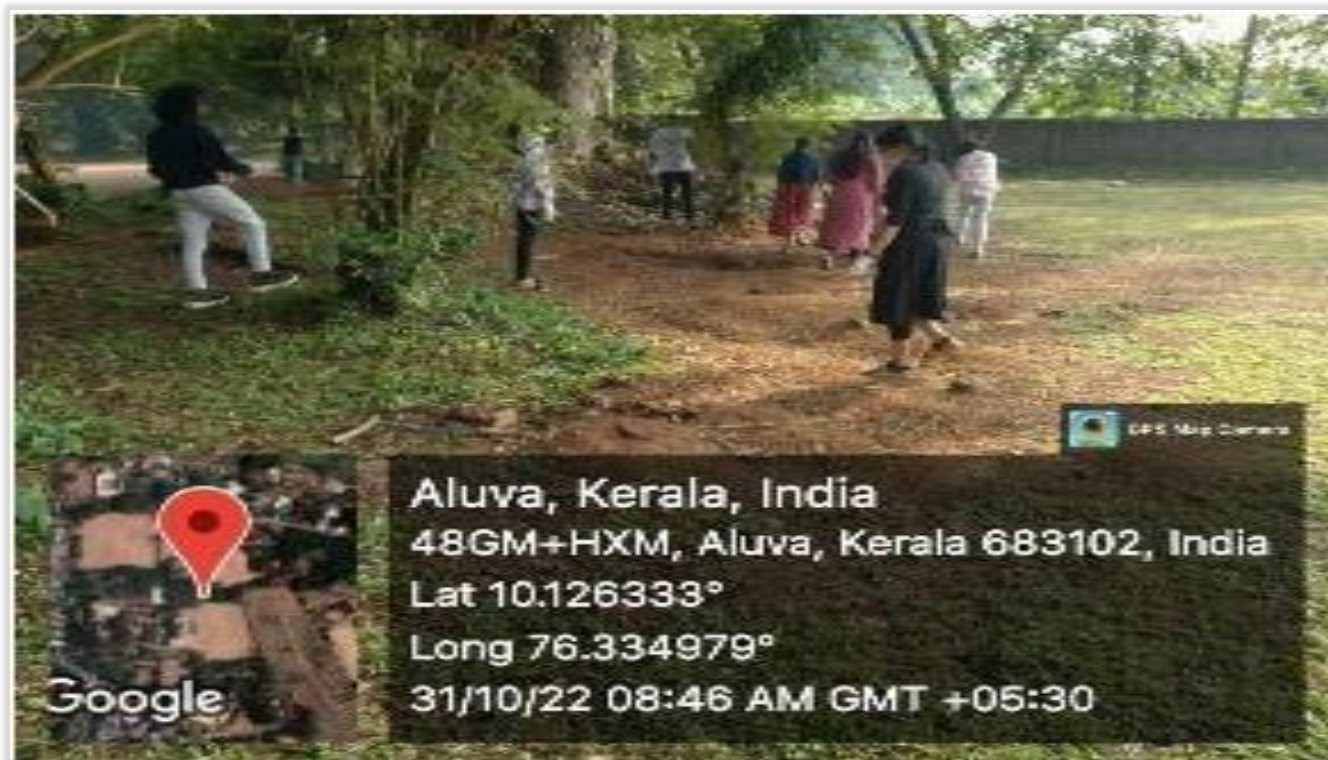

Talks on Ecological importance of Mangroves and its conservation

Kallen Pokkudan
Kallen Pokkudan was an Indian environmentalist and social activist who dedicated his life to the conservation of mangrove forests in Kerala, India. He was known for his innovative approach to mangrove conservation, which involved working closely with local communities and empowering them to take ownership of the forests. He set up several community-led mangrove conservation projects and helped establish a mangrove research and training center in Kerala. His efforts were crucial in protecting the fragile mangrove ecosystems and the livelihoods of the local communities that depend on them. Kallen Pokkudan passed away in 2015, but his legacy lives on through the many people he inspired to take up the cause of mangrove conservation.

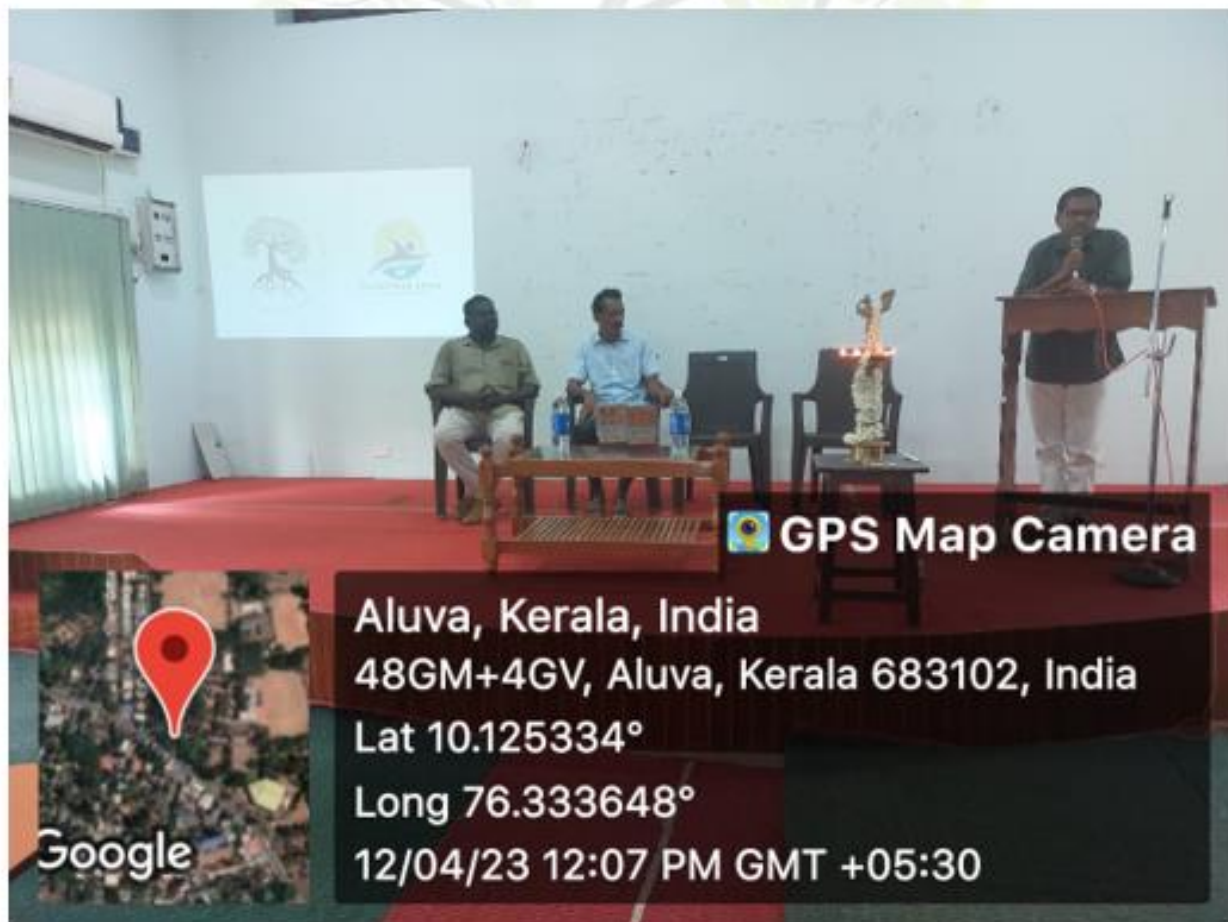
