1. Chekutty Dolls Making




2. Seminar on challenges faced by Women Entrepreneurs- Inauguration of Women Cell

2. Type of IP and Brief Introduction to Patenting process in India




2. Marodanachu

Gender in everyday life



4. On Doing Gender History




6. Politics of Gender/Caste

7. Beyond Law: Women, Power and (In)Justice




1. A webinar on ‘Trans Inclusive Society’

2. IP Commercialization




3. LET's Talk' -An interactive webinar


5. Webinar on Legal Protection for Women- Challenges and Possibilities

6. Webinar on 'Sthreeswathwa Nirmithi Vedethihasangaliloode'.




7. Webinar on Sex education


9. Premarital Counselling Programme for Minority Welfare

10. Webinar on Hijras in Gharanas




11. Paper Back: Book Discussion Forum

12. Seminar on Gender Discourse in Contemporary Society




13. Webinar – Women’s Participation in the Democratic Process

14. Signature Board




15. Break the Bias




4. Menstrual Hygiene Campaign




students participated in the programme from different departments. The resource person was Ms. Jesna P. J., Sales promoter of C & A Healthcare.

7. Outreach Campaign on Menstrual Practices and Reproductive Health



8. Self Defense Class




9. Gender Auditing in Relationship and Friendship

10. Women Self defence Workshop


