Alumni Engagement

The alumni association of Union Christian College has been functioning for many years as a supportive organ of the college. Though a formal Constitution for the Association was adopted in February, 1969 it received an official registration under Travancore-Cochin Literary, Scientific and Charitable Societies Registration Act, 1955 (Kerala Act 12 of 1955) in 2023. The College is blessed with its own unique traditions and our family of alumni and friends living all around the globe look to UCC with great warmth and gratitude and yearn to maintain a lifelong connection with their alma mater. The Union Christian College Alumni Association was established in response to this recognized need and plays a pivotal role in keeping them all connected.

The feeling of having the legacy of a common brotherhood is shared on **every second Saturday of November**, when the past and present generations unite together in the Varkey Memorial Hall for General Body meetings and discussions. This is also an occasion when the alumni, retired teaching and non-teaching staff and the present college community celebrate their success and various achievements. An induction ceremony of the newly appointed faculty is done on that day and the retiring teachers and non-teachers are also honoured. The winners of the all Kerala Inter Collegiate elocution and quiz competitions namely, Prof. E. Narayanan Nambiar memorial trophies for English Elocution and Malayalam Elocution, Prof. A.K. Abdul Kareem Memorial Quiz trophy instituted by the alumni are awarded with cash prize, trophy and certificates. The OSA executive committee presents the accounts and discusses the future plans on the same day. A number of other events are arranged by the Association during the year. These include a July meet on second Saturday in July, batch reunions, lectures, topical seminars, newsletters, alumni web site, etc. The college warmly welcomes recommendations from the alumni on improving the academic quality, supporting research projects, promoting industrial liaison in collaborative research, international linkage, or developing value-added alumni projects.

UCCAAK: The UCC Alumni Association of Kuwait is an organization of the alumni and friends of UC College formed in 2009.


UCC - UAE: The UCC Alumni Association of UAE was formed as an organization of the alumni and friends of UC College in 2013.

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






Bills of the books contributed to the Dept of Malayalam library



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
