PARTICIPATORY LEADERSHIP

Union Christian College's commitment to providing a socially relevant education coupled with its participatory governance style became visible in the college's involvement in *2018 deluge and in the management of the COVID - 19 pandemic*

Floods of August 2018

Carving good citizens out of the youth that enter the portals of the college is the hallmark quality of Union Christian College. The year 2018 witnessed one of the worst floods that ravaged the state and Aluva was at the heart of its fury. Union Christian College was a light house that guided thousands to safety, warmth and resilience. The college leadership including teaching and non-teaching staff members and students plunged into immediate action with teachers and students of the college rendering voluntary service to the need of the community. The college became one of the largest refugee camps in Kerala. For around two weeks, the entire campus served as a relief camp for over 13000 people from in and around Aluva.

All the buildings of the college were utilised as relief camps. **Union Christian College received an award from the Government of Kerala honouring the services rendered to society.**

Covid 19

During the unprecedented Covid 19 pandemic and the lockdown thereafter, yet again the college opened its doors to the public. The college auditorium became a First Line Treatment Centre (FLTC) for the Kerala Government's fight against Covid 19. Students and teachers of the college engaged with the panchayat and municipality. A massive vaccination drive was carried out by local bodies in the campus for residents of the town. Teachers served the role of Sectoral Magistrate to ensure community compliance to norms for civic health. Free online counseling services were offered for public by the staff and students of psychology department. Awareness campaigns were organised to dissipate knowledge and instill confidence within the community.

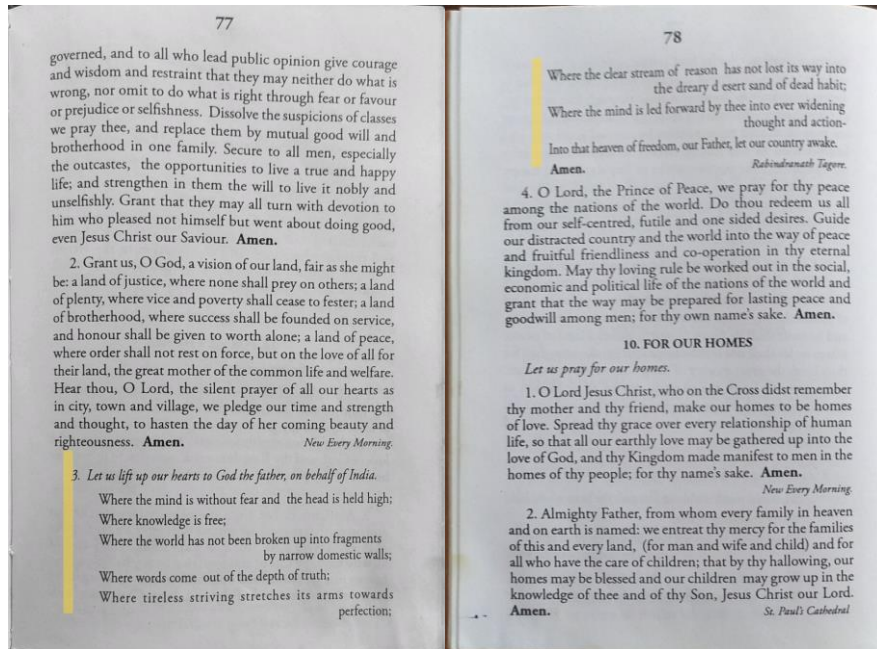
Excerpt from The Constitution of Union Christian College, Aluva

“ The College was a venture in cooperation among some members of the Malankara Syrian Church, the Malankara Marthoma Syrian Church and the Anglican Church in Travancore and Cochin. The management of the internal life of the College was in the hands of a fellowship of teachers with a Principal chosen by the Fellowship from among its members for a period of five years at a time and of a Senatus consisting mostly of the members of the Fellowship...”
