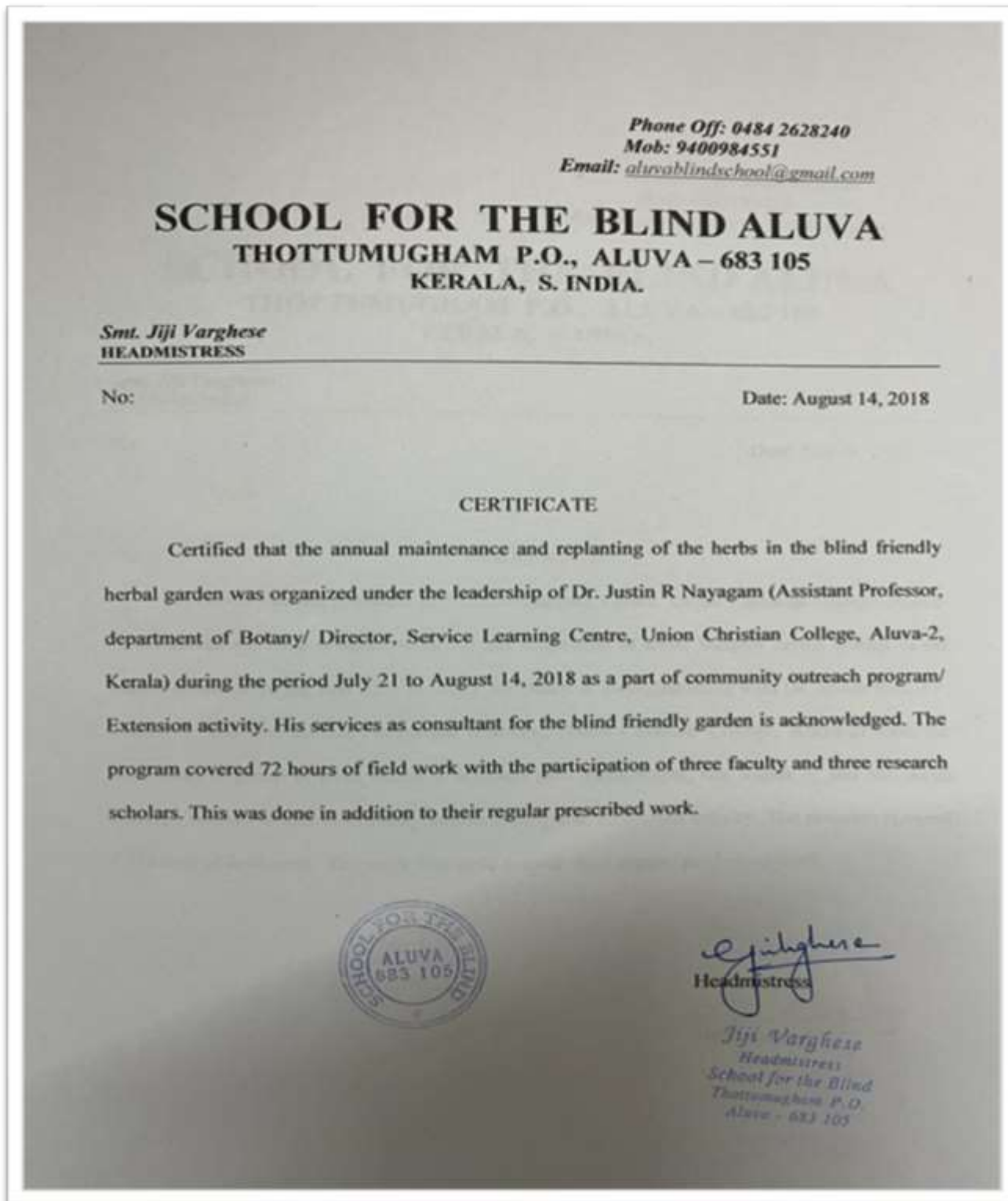

2018-2019

1. Dr. Justin R Nayagam provided Consultancy service for Annual maintenance and replacement of Herbs in the Blind School Aluva during July 21-August 14, 2018.





2. Cleaning and Chlorination at Mambra

As part of disinfecting drive against the epidemic spread, several houses and its premises were cleaned and chlorinated by NSS volunteers at Mambra of Karumalloor Panchayat on 12th and 13th August, 2018. 30 volunteers took part in the programme.





3. School Cleaning

At the onset, the one-day miniature camp held on 8th September 2018 aimed in joining the cleanliness activities at Chamaparambu Government L. P. School near to UC college, Aluva. NSS volunteers cleared up the ground and surroundings thereby creating a warm and pleasant atmosphere. Volunteers





prepared an herbal garden in the school. They also planted saplings of trees in the school compound. The Teachers and PTA of the School directed the volunteers for the cleaning work.

4. Socio - Economic - Health Survey

As part of the Shuchithva Mission Programme NSS Unit conduct a Socio – Economic - Health survey in ward XVIII (Manakkappadi South) of Karumalloor Grama Panchayat of Ernakulum District during 23 – 25 December, 2018. Volunteers visited 396 houses. They also gave an orientation about ‘how can we reduce plastic waste’, ‘handling of bio waste’, ‘organic farming’ etc. We are planning to submit the analysis report of our survey by the end of January 2019 to the Panchayat and will take necessary steps



towards improving the cleanliness of ward XVIII of Karumalloor Panchayat.

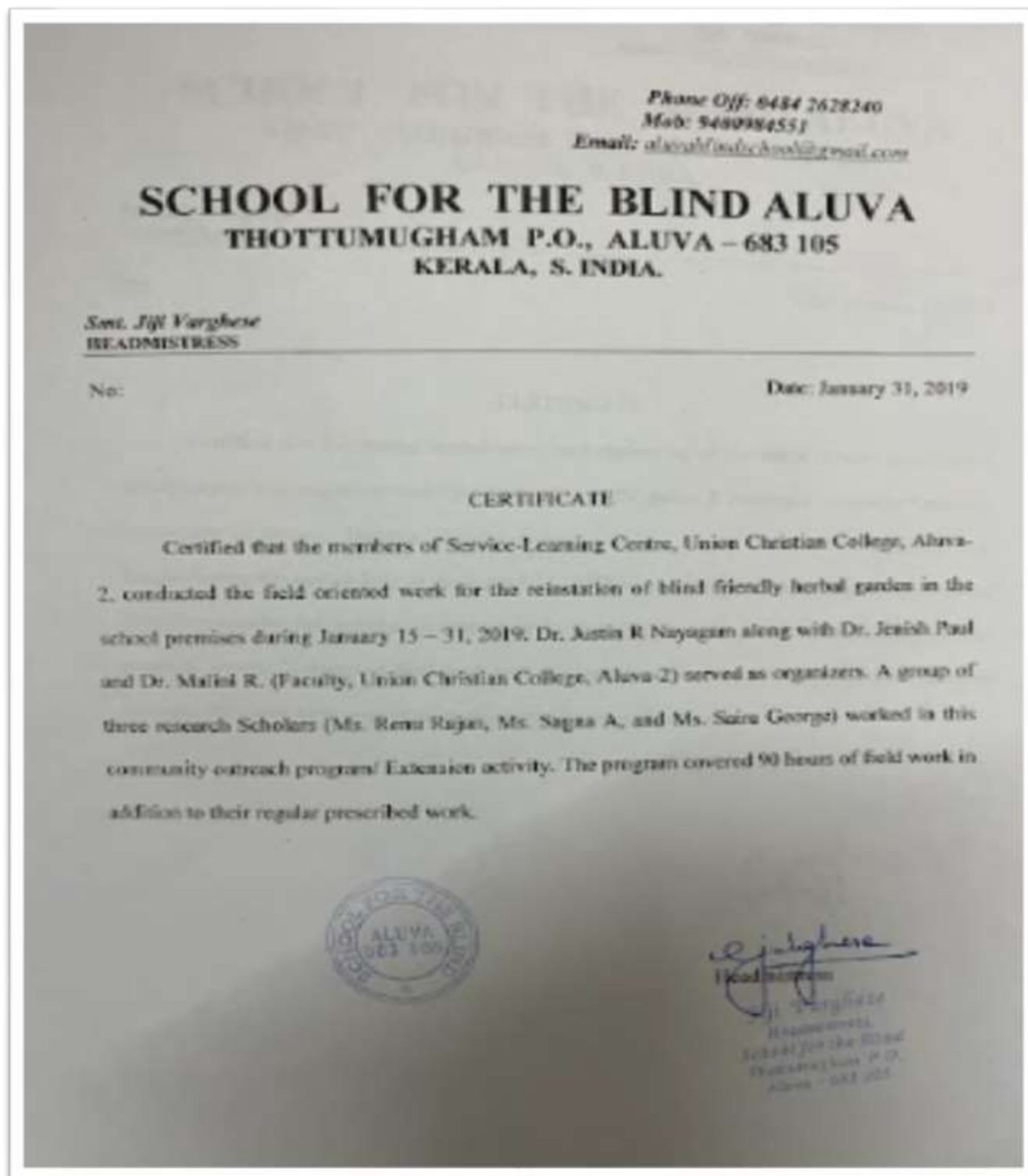


7. Dr. Justin R Nayagam provided support for setting up of blind friendly herbal garden at Blind School, Aluva during January 15-31, 2019.



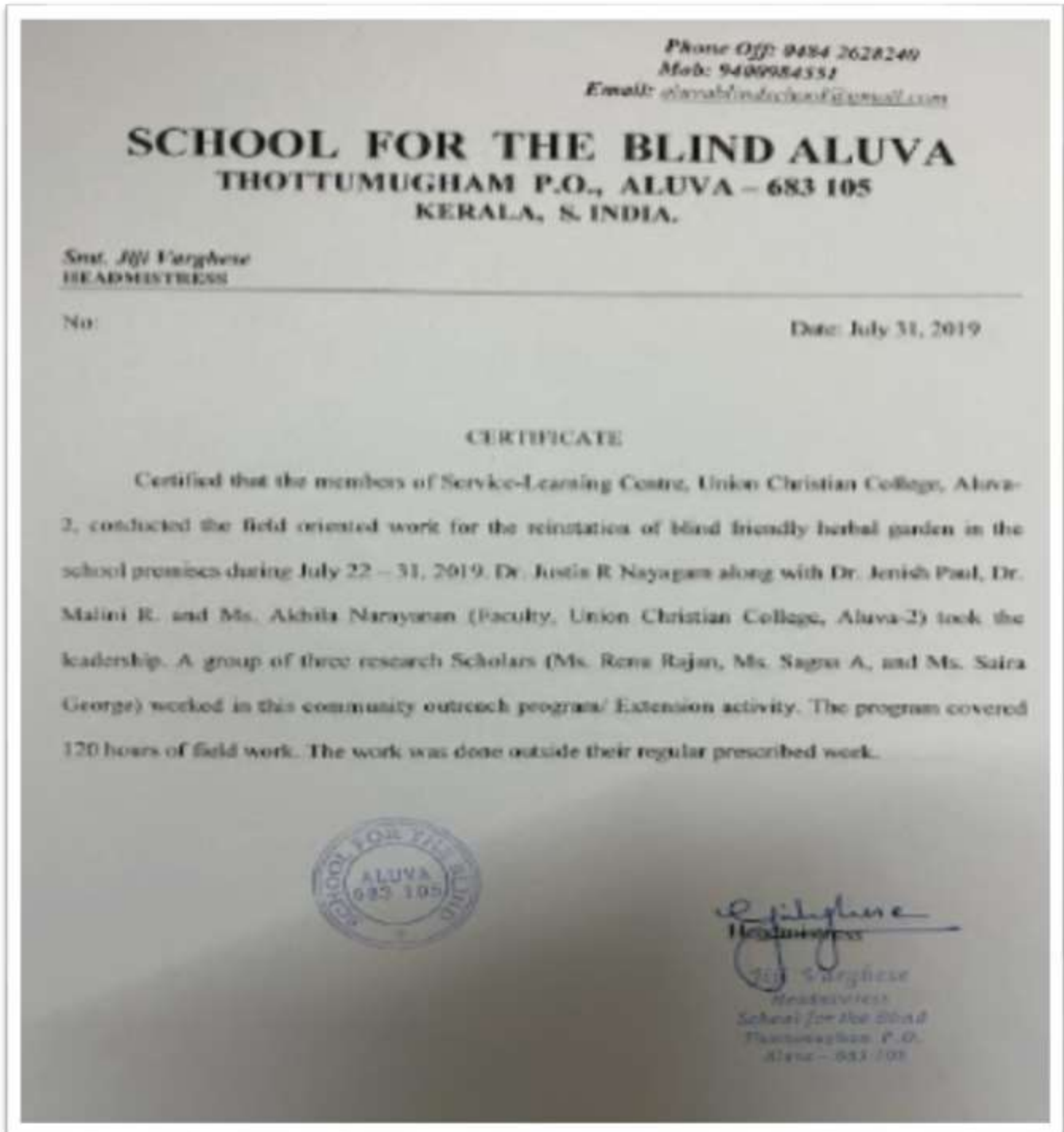
2019-2020

Talks on Ecological importance of Mangroves and its conservation

Kallen Pokkudan

Kallen Pokkudan was an Indian environmentalist and social activist who dedicated his life to the conservation of mangrove forests in Kerala, India. He was known for his innovative approach to mangrove conservation, which involved working closely with local communities and empowering them to take ownership of the forests. He set up several community-led mangrove conservation projects and helped establish a mangrove research and training center in Kerala. His efforts were crucial in protecting the fragile mangrove ecosystems and the livelihoods of the local communities that depend on them. Kallen Pokkudan passed away in 2015, but his legacy lives on through the many people he inspired to take up the cause of mangrove conservation.
